Impress will open most PowerPoint files and will Save As a .ppt file.

Why Use PowerPoint?

- Integration of visual resources
- Easy re-distribution
- Organize yourself

What do YOU want to do with "PowerPoint?"

Running PowerPoint Presentations

- Saved as a "PowerPoint" (.PPT or .PPTX) or "Impress" (.ODP) file
- Distributed as an Adobe .PDF (Portable Document File) file

Viewing a Presentation

- Open the presentation file (.ppt, .pptx, .odp)
 - Start your computer
 - Go to <u>Venable-PowerPoint</u> @ <u>Max Speed</u> folder on Desktop
 - Load <u>EX_1-Running_OOP.odp</u>
- Press [F5]
- The presentation file includes most pictures, etc.
- Press [Esc] to exit presentation mode

Viewing a Presentation Saved as a .PDF File
