"Field Trips"

The road North – A - cross Westover Bridge. Follow Holland Ave. to "the Triangle," keep right on Route 100. Follow 100 to US 19, then Right on 19. Follow 19 to Washington PA

The road North – B - cross Westover Bridge. Follow Holland Ave. to "the Triangle," keep right on Route 100. Follow 100 to Fort Martin Road (100 leaves the River) After entering PA, turn Right at stop sign (several miles), descend hill to Mon River, turn left on PA 88, and head north until you see signs for Greenboro. Turn right and descend to Greensboro. Then look for your boat.

The road South - cross Westover Bridge. Follow Holland Ave. to "the Triangle," keep left. Follow 19 to Fairmont.

The road West - cross Westover Bridge. Follow Hollan Ave. to "the Triangle," keep right on Route 100. Follow 100 Jimtown Underpass (under Star City Bridge), then left through Osage to 19. Follow 19 to WV Route 7. Turn left and go to New Martinsville.

The road East - go up Wiley Street (US 119) to Mileground. Follow 119 through Easton then right, followed by quick left on old Pierpont Road. Follow old Pierpont Road to Cheat Lake. Cross old bridge (if possible) then take I-67 to Bruceton Mills. Take ?? to Markleysburg, PA. Turn right on US Route 40 and follow 40 to Cumberland, MD.
