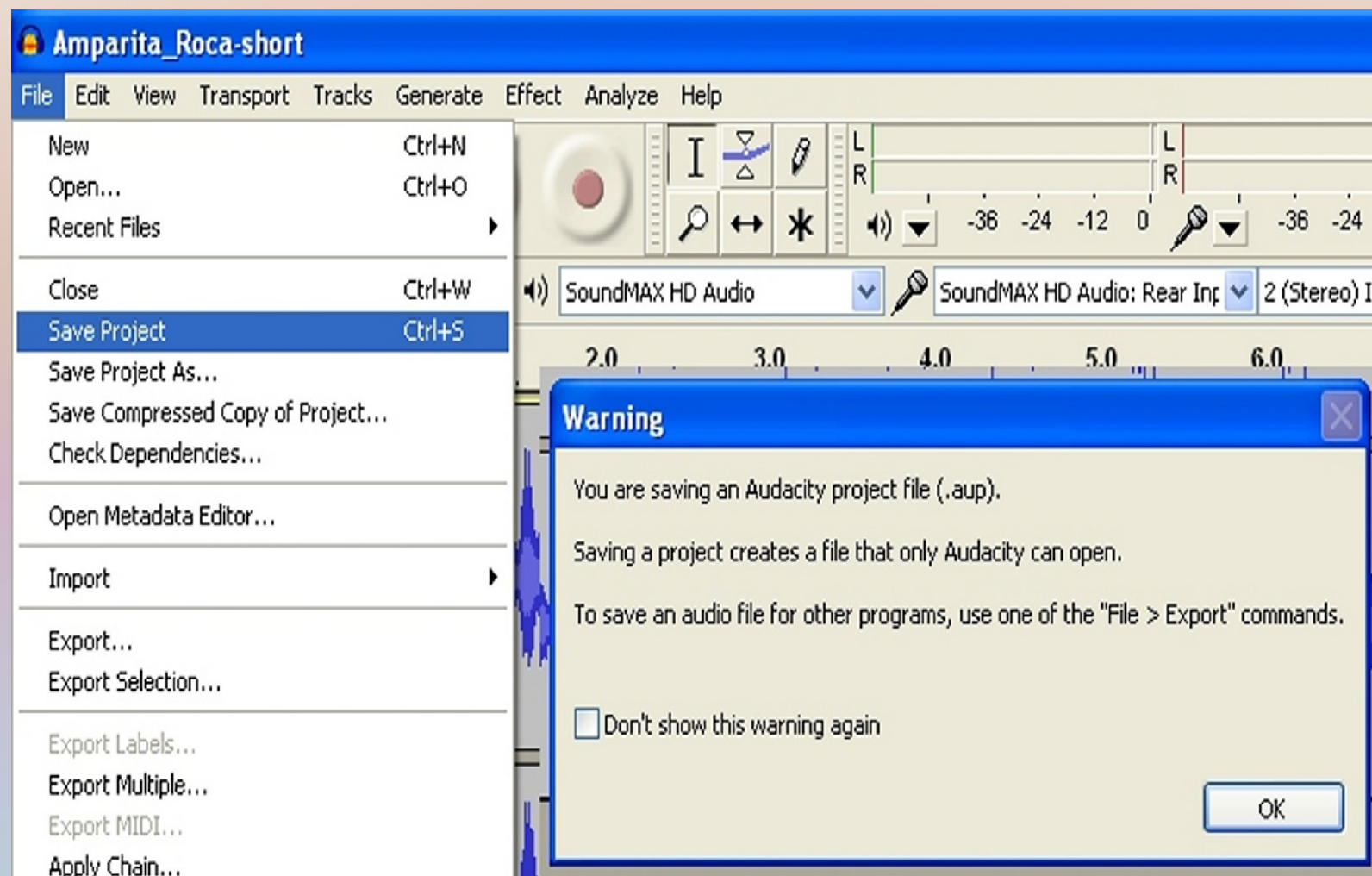

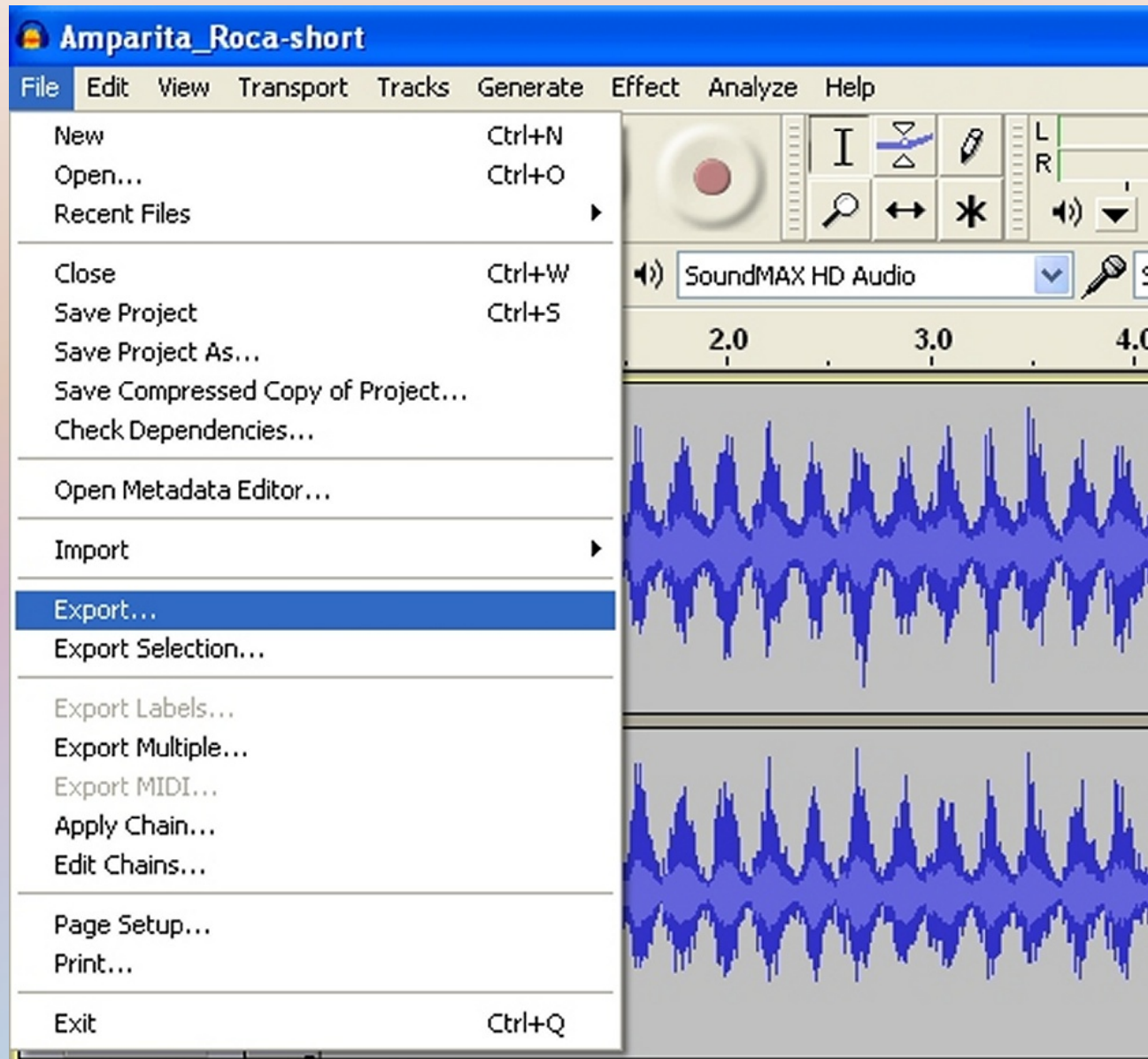

Exporting/Saving to Files

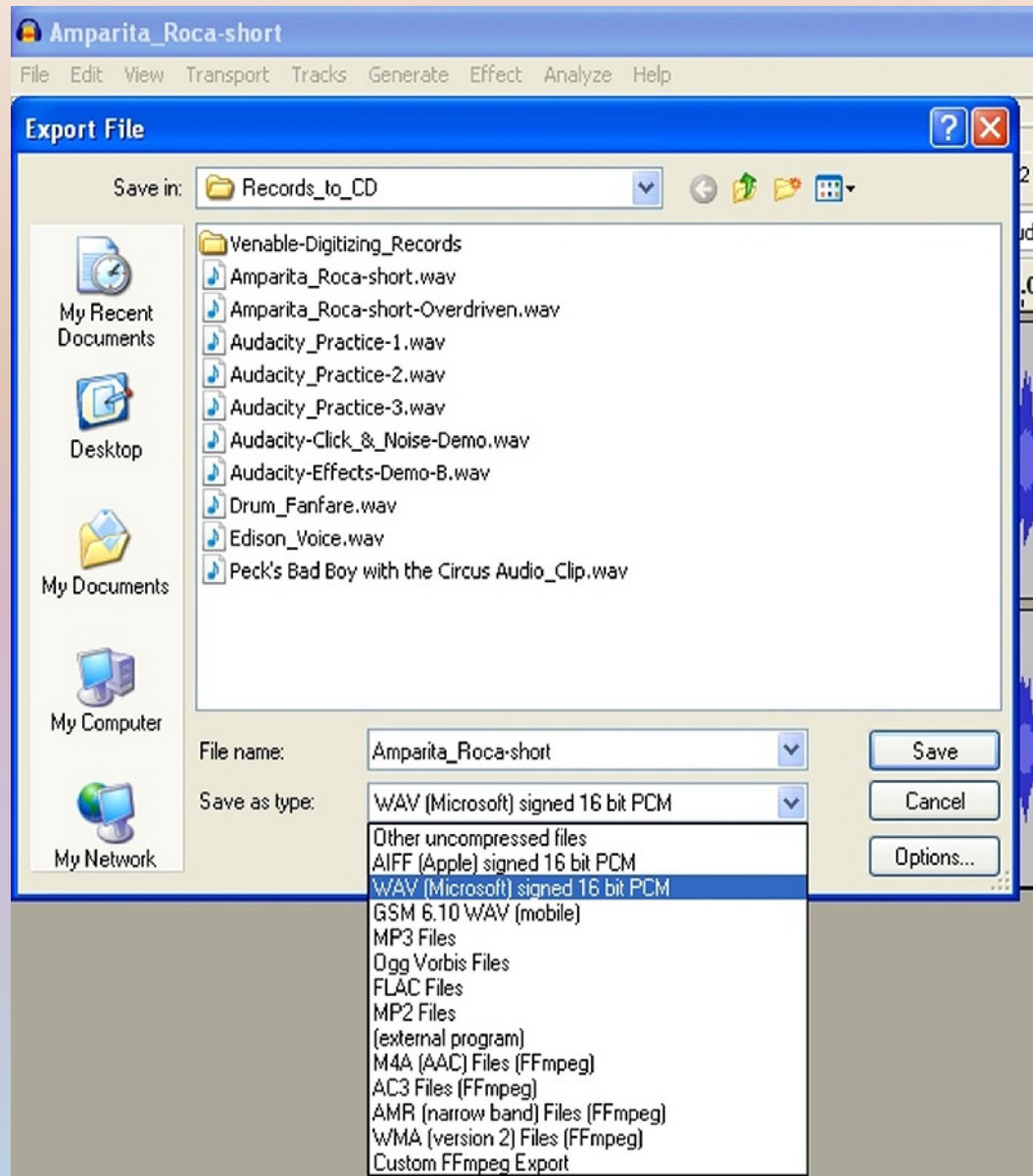
Audacity does not “Save” audio files !



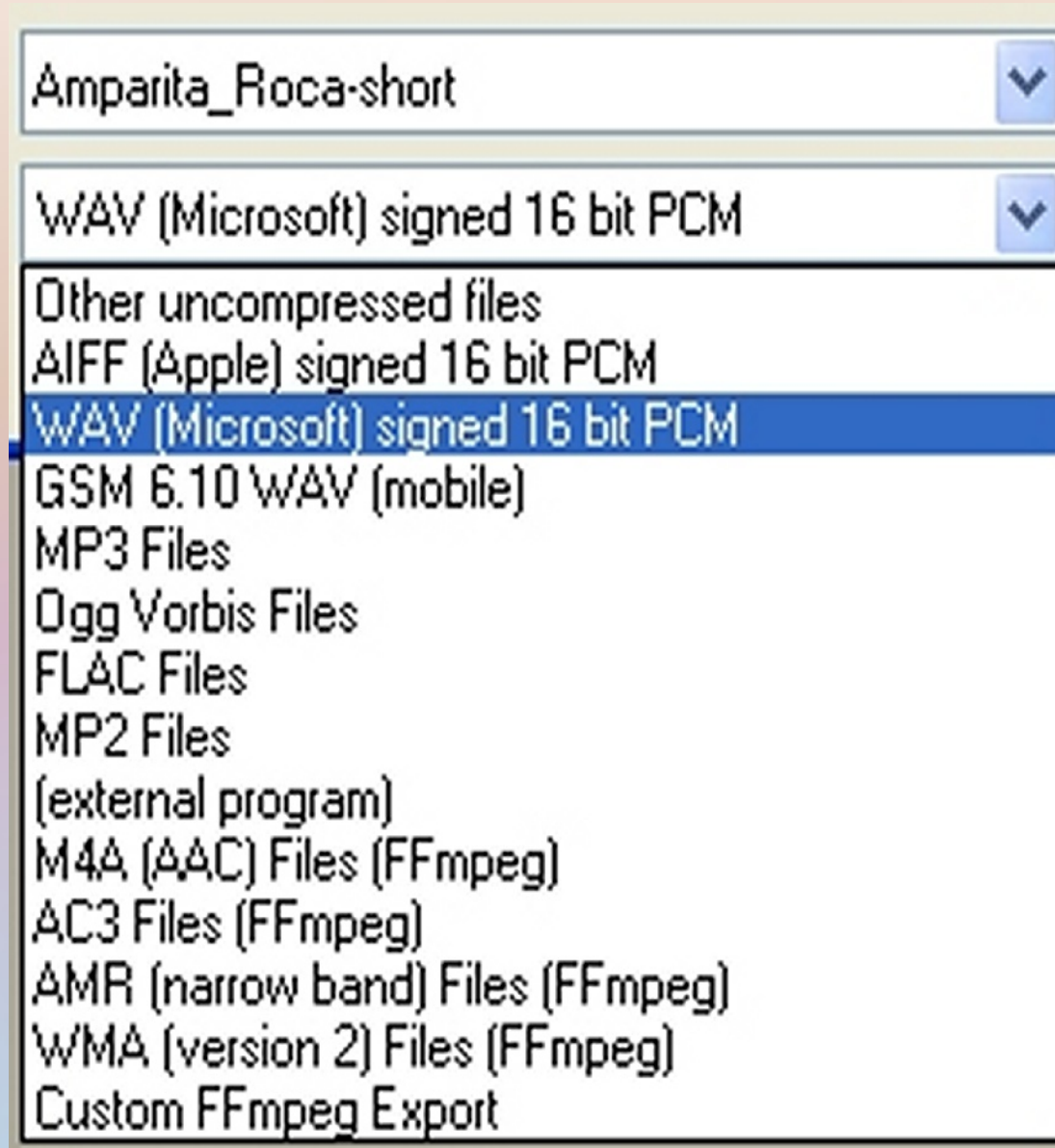



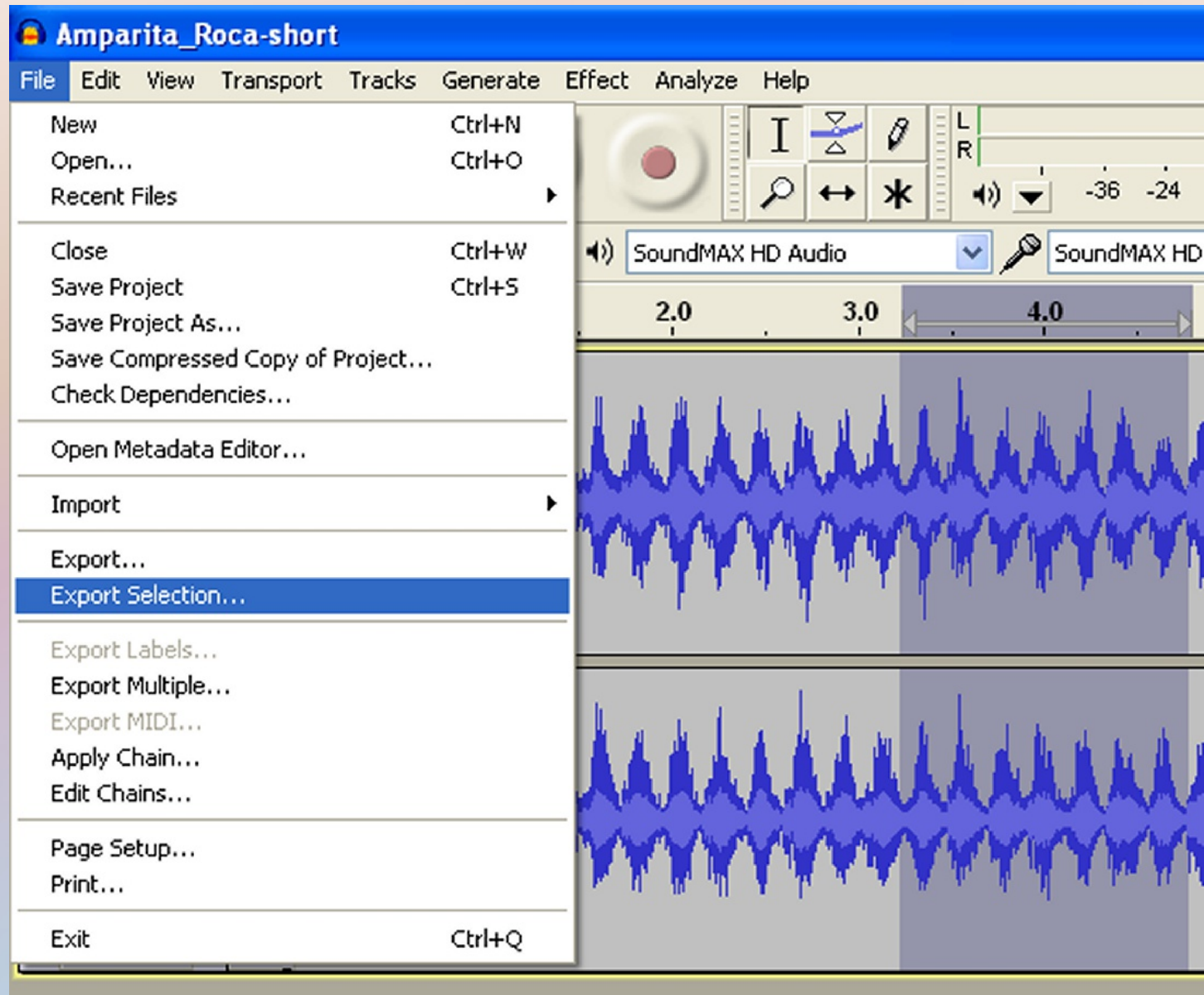
